It is clear from travelling the land this year that Salers are now taken very seriously. They do what they say they do as all those who have them know! It is down to us all to promote the breed further and the council has set up a group to look at the website with input from some of our younger members, we are looking at marketing and promotional material and continuing the Herd Health plan. However sometimes it is the simple things that promote the breed—word of mouth! We had a good sale at Castle Douglas, heifers making good trade. Not quite so good with the bulls, but with the weather being like it has, everyone is looking at feed costs and space this winter so perhaps we might see a good trade in Spring. It was the 21st anniversary of the sale and dinner at Castle Douglas and a time to reflect on the years, the society has had its ups and downs as we all do, but it was pointed out just how far the society has come over the years since its inception in 1985 when Bryan Walling brought in the first herd from France. There have been times when the society was in danger of collapse, but with the dedication of those involved it turned into a successful, forward thinking financially viable operation. We have many members over the years to thank, and I believe there will be others in the future as we gain in popularity.

With our future in mind the council are already looking into the next steps re health, rules, regulations etc.

The council has a meeting coming up in January to discuss and clarify rules and regulations of the society. These should be reviewed periodically to ensure we are keeping up to date and that our membership are kept up to date.

The council have over the years been collating information on animal weights and scrotal sizes at society sales, with this information it has been decided to introduce the following as from 1 January which will become mandatory at society sales from 1 May.

A bull may be rejected if he doesn't meet the following criteria. If there is doubt then measurement will be taken twice, with the owner/handler present

#### **Scrotal Size**

Up to 18months = 32cm 18—24months = 34cm Over 24months = 36cm

#### Weights

As per the society guidelines given out with sale entry forms. The weights and scrotal sizes will be displayed on pens cards at





Next on our agenda for herd health is IBR and Lepto. The industry is heavily into herd health and the Salers society is seen as a for runner in actively seeking correct advise and taking effective action. We hope to continue this for the benefit of all members and potential purchasers of Salers, farmers want to know the animals they buy in are from good healthy stock.

Another on going project has been the updating of the herd book, for the last two years lists of animals have been sent to every member. These are animals listed to your herd. The aim is to ensure the society herd book is up to date and accurate to enable us and the necessary authorities have up to date information of Salers in the UK. This information can be used for planning our marketing and promotional campaign's, as those who attended the AGM will know, the information is very useful for predicting trends within the industry. It has therefore been agreed by council to have an annual census, a listing of animals allocated to your herd will be sent annually and should be returned updated as required. If you don't return

your listing within 6 months, then you will not be able to register animals until it is completed, this will reduce to 3 months in the second year. This is to ensure we do keep accurate records.
