IMPORTING SALERS

More and more breeders are turning to importing animals as the Salers breed becomes more popular and new blood lines are needed with this comes increasing admin costs, so as from 1st January 2018 the cost of imports will rise to reflect the time taken to

complete this task.
All costs, forms and information can be found on the website under Useful Info/Resources
It is important to check all information when importing animals from outside the United Kingdom.
Pedigree Salers from other countries (including ROI) must have

- 1. a valid export pedigree certificate from the country of origin society,
- 2. the animal must have a laboratory report stating the animal is a non carrier of Beta mannosidosis,
- 3. and if it is male it is worth getting the DNA profile report (if not you will have to have the animal tested here (at your cost).

You have three months from date of import to register the animal (with all relevant paperwork) before penalties occur. Please ensure you get this paperwork when arranging to bring animals in from another country.



All stock bulls must be SNP DNA tested before any resultant calves can be registered. You can get hair sample test kits from the office, or you can use tissue samples from special ear tags. The test costs £25 plus vat = £30. Additional testing is optional Horned/Polled is £30 plus vat, Beef Profile is £35 plus vat. A special combined price for SNP profile and Horn/Poll gene is available for £40 plus vat. Please ensure hair samples are clean. The society is now testing

The society is now testing for myostatins too, this is at the cost of the society and for data collection only at this stage. Aquarian Embroidery, hold the new Salers logo, which can be reproduced on any product along with your herd/farm name as required. 
Newsletter
